Karen's work is diverse and exciting, and encompasses a wide range of styles and aesthetics. Magdalene Odundo and Juan Quezada have inspired her to create ethnic work with African, American Indian and Hispanic flavors. Her beautiful lidded boxes, which are also for sale at Van Gogh's Ear in Prescott and the Raku Gallery in Jerome, have a decidedly Asian influence.

Karen has personally taken workshops from ceramic's masters such as Juan Quezada, Paul Soldner and Otto Heino. Along with functional work, she also creates beautiful large sculptural pieces. In addition to taking many workshops, she teaches adult and children's classes in hand building, coiling and wheel throwing. She holds an "open studio" for locals on Tuesdays and Wednesdays year-round. When she's not teaching she hosts workshops with 3 or 4 visiting artists during the year. Adjoining her studio is the vanPrice Gallery, which is open year round by appointment.

One of the most unique aspects of Karen's work includes her original ceramic neti pots that are sold both wholesale and resale. Who says your useful item can't also be a work of art? Karen is also a certified RYT yoga instructor and teaches regular classes in her yoga studio.
